- All physical mediums are acceptable - paints, pencils, collage, etc.
- Digital artwork is also acceptable
- No AI generated or edited artwork (DALL-E, ChatGPT, Midjourney, Adobe Firefly, etc.)

### Judging Criteria:

- Interpretation of the music
- Creativity and originality
- Artistic skill and technique
- Overall impact and visual appeal.

### Prizes:

- The winning art will be projected during the concert or featured on the CMSFW social media pages.

### Age Categories:

- Rising Artists: Up to 7
- Aspiring Artists: 8-12
- Emerging Artists: 13-18
